J.L. Wallace Completes Construction of Water Field Operations Center Warehouse

FORT MYERS, FL. (Nov. 15, 2010) – J.L. Wallace Inc. has completed construction of the Water Field Operations Center Warehouse in Cocoa, FL. The facility will be the communications headquarters for the City of Cocoa Utilities Division with capabilities for on-site training.

The project included a 53,549 SF two-story tilt-up concrete construction structure. The 46,288 SF first floor consists of warehouse and shop space with the 7,261 SF second floor used for offices. The exterior has a painted stucco finish with accent textured banding. Additional features include aluminum canopies, food service equipment, crane system, loading dock area, audio-visual capabilities, CATV and security systems.

Architectural design was provided by Architects in Association Rood and Zwick, Inc. Structural, mechanical and electrical engineers were TLC and civil engineers were Quentin L. Hampton Associates, Inc.

Harold Morgan was the senior project manager with Joe Clark and Glenn Cribbett as superintendents and Robbyn Spears as senior project manager assistant.
