New Airplane Hangars Nearly Finished at Venice Municipal Airport

FORT MYERS, FLA. (March 12, 2012) – J.L. Wallace, Inc. is nearing completion of improvements to the Venice Municipal Airport. The project includes a new airplane hangar building and improvements to the airport's taxiways.

The project is jointly funded by the City of Venice and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) through a joint participation agreement, with FDOT paying 80% of the cost.

The hangar is a pre-engineered metal building of nearly 13,000 square feet that will feature eight nested T-hangars with horizontal bi-fold doors that fold up and out when open. In addition to the building, the project includes a new taxiway connecting the hangar to the runway and to an existing group of T-hangars. New taxiway lights, some drainage work, and paving are also part of the project.

This new eight-unit hangar is the first of several phases that will add more airplane storage space at the airport that the city can lease to aircraft owners.

Ted Gadoury is serving as project manager for the \$820,000 project. Jeff Brunderman is the superintendent and Robbyn Spears is serving as project manager assistant. Engineering services have been provided by Hanson Professional Services of Lakewood Ranch, Fla.
